The Centennial Celebration continued during the last half of 2023 and culminated with a Time Capsule Ceremony in January 2024. Plans are to open the Time Capsule in 20 years. Awareness was the main goal for our Centennial year. We wanted more people to know about our important work and Vera Lloyd gained many new supporters, followers and friends through those efforts.

Our secondary goal for the Centennial was fundraising, specifically for Phase 1 of renovating our multi-purpose gym. I am pleased to report that many generous gifts made that possible. - Continued to enhance our clinical services to help meet the mental health and behavioral needs of our youth 24-7.
- Increased security on campus to help ensure the safety of our youth and staff.
- Blessed to have several youth complete their treatment at Vera Lloyd and go to a forever home!

- Enrolled in educational program and/or employed


Schmidt Center Counseling

- Helps build community among foster and adoptive parents


June 2023 - July 2024 Fiscal Year







ONE OF THOSE PLACES IS VERA LLOYD.





- **In Honor of Gift** – A gift in honor of someone special. Birthdays, holidays and “just because” are all great reasons to make an honor gift.


